THE JURY APPROVED that in considering the testimony of my previously listed witness who may have testified in this case you are as follows, and agree to trust such testimony as given by an interested person, and give it no other weight than it is worth a really disinterested witness. That you have no right, as jurors, to stimulate such witness singly and only for the reason that they have been thus employed, but you would give to their testimony the very same weight as to any other testimony. In this case, giving it such weight as, considering the weight of the case, their opportunities for making the facts of which they testify, and their uprightness and honesty upon the witness stand, and all the other elements which go to their credibility, in the case, their interest and bias, and to give their testimony such weight as, under all the circumstances, the case is, in your judgment, demanded to receive.
